**Visa:**

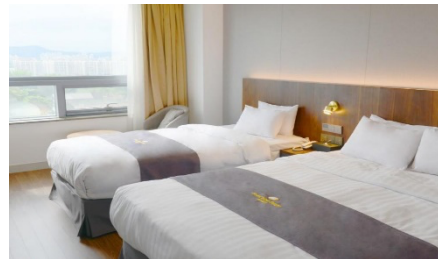
All participants who need an entry visa to Korea will be required to complete the **Visa Support Letter section** in WAREOS by no later than **12 July 2023**.
